

Acetic Acid Food Grade

Product Description

Acetic acid (C₂H₄O₂) is a clear colorless liquid with a strong odor of vinegar. The US Food and Drug Administration has regulations for acetic acid in 21 CFR 184.1005. Acetic acid is Affirmed GRAS (Generally Recognized as Safe) and may be used subject to restrictions listed on the regulations. The Acetic acid Food Grade is judged to be produced and handled in accordance with current Good Manufacturing Practices (cGMP) and will meet all the acetic acid specifications as set forth in Food Chemical Codex (FCC), current edition.
