

## Product Regulatory Statement

### Communication about INEOS Composites' position on CLP harmonised format for notifications according to article 45 of CLP Regulation (Annex VIII)

February 2023

Dear customer,

According to Article 45 of the CLP Regulation, companies placing hazardous mixtures on the market are obliged to provide information about certain hazardous mixtures to the relevant Poison Center, so that they can give advice to the citizens or medical personnel in the event of an emergency. Annex VIII of the CLP Regulation, adopted in March 2017, defines the harmonised requirements for Poison Center notifications (PCN) applicable as of 1 January 2021.

Submissions must be made in the harmonised format with UFI (Unique Formula Identifier) to be included in labels and in SDS. Relevant dates are:

- Obligation to notify a new mixture placed on the market after 1 January 2021 for consumer or professional use.
- Obligation to notify a new mixture placed on the market after 1 January 2024 for industrial uses.

Ineos Composites will follow the above applicability dates so you can expect UFI in the label and SDS according to the mixture's use for the new mixtures placed on the market after 1 January 2021.

Mixtures placed on the market before 1 January 2021 were notified to the corresponding national Poison Center. The obligation to notify them under harmonised format is 1 January 2025.
