

FACT SHEET – Combined Operations at Breagh A Platform with the Maersk Resolve Drill Rig

**Breagh A Installation:
Combined Operations with Maersk Resolve**

The Breagh A gas production platform, operated by INEOS UK SNS Ltd ('INEOS Oil & Gas UK'), is located in the Southern North Sea UKCS Block 42/13a. The platform was installed in 2011 and gas production commenced in October 2013.

Breagh A is a normally unmanned installation where crews visit periodically for routine or unplanned maintenance. Production operations are controlled remotely from the TGPP (Teesside Gas Processing Plant) onshore terminal. Produced gas is transferred by a 100 km 20-inch Gas Export Pipeline that connects the Breagh A platform to a shore landfall at Coatham Sands where a 20-inch onshore pipeline continues to TGPP. A 3-inch MEG pipeline runs alongside the 20-inch line.

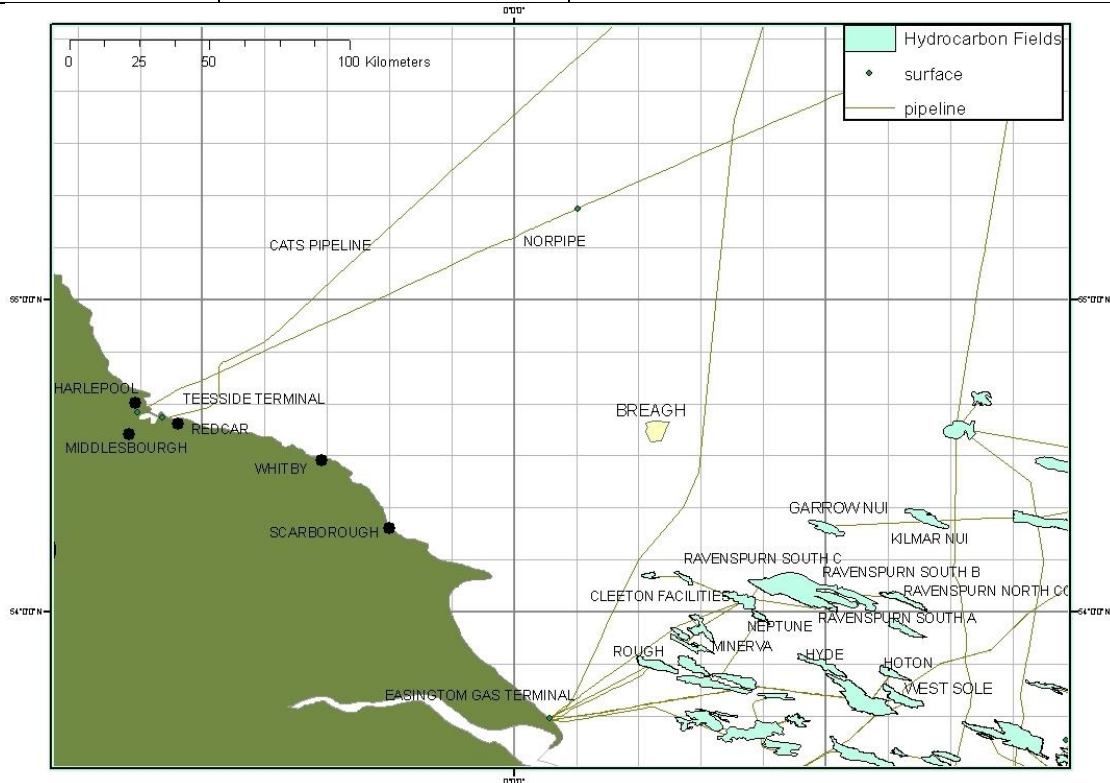
The jack-up drilling rig '*RESOLVE*', owned by Maersk Drilling Holdings Singapore and operated by Maersk Drilling UK Limited, is positioned alongside the Breagh A platform and is engaged in drilling, completion, stimulation and testing of one well on behalf of INEOS Oil & Gas UK.
